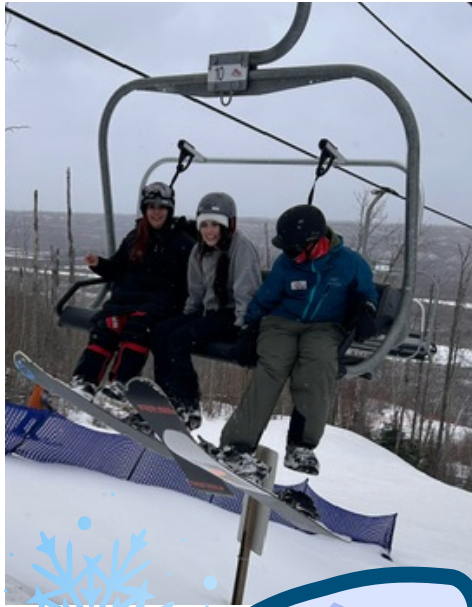

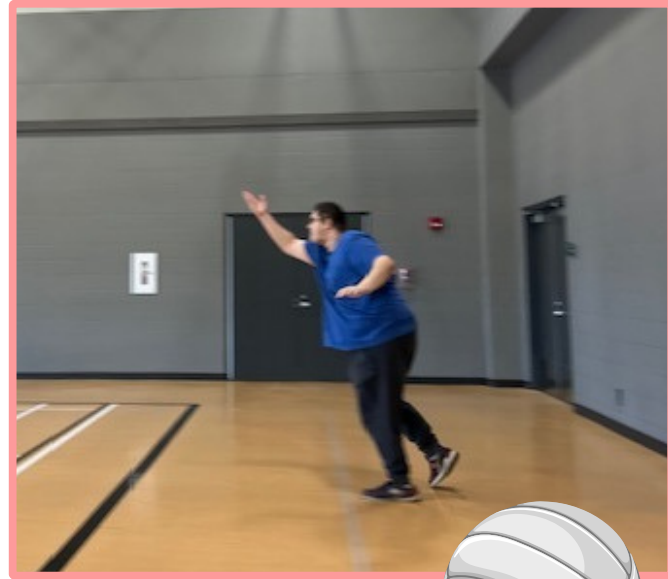
PD Session

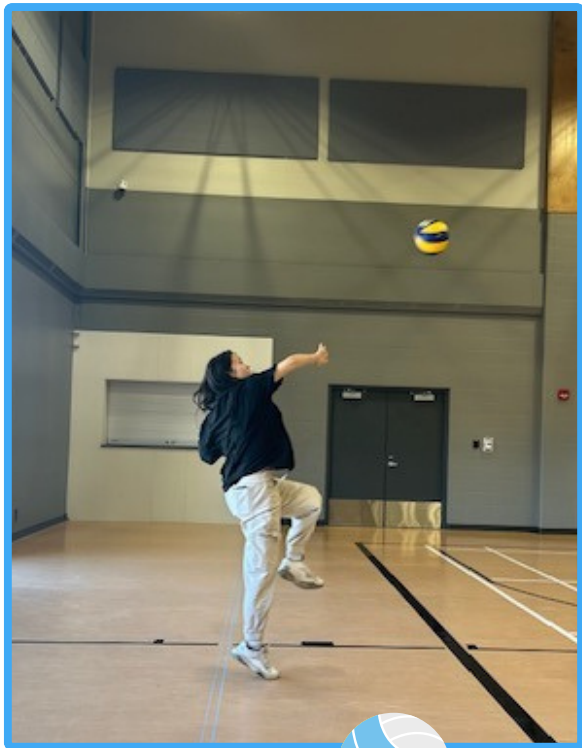
